## READ

You'll want to start by reading the piece with a focus on:



### AUDIENCE

Who is this for?



### PURPOSE

Why was it created?



### DESIGN

How is the info presented?

## SUMMARIZE

Draft and share a summary of the piece. How do you understand the audience, purpose, and design as reader?

**"THIS IS WHAT I LEARNED/KNOW/UNDERSTOOD FROM THIS TEXT--IS THAT WHAT YOU INTENDED?"**

## RESPOND

Speak to audience and purpose THROUGH THE LENS of design.

**HOW IS [SPECIFIC DESIGN ELEMENT] GETTING IN THE WAY OF UNDERSTANDING [AUDIENCE OR PURPOSE]?**

## INSTEAD OF...

Change the color of this.



This formatting/capitalization is inconsistent.



This element is too small/large.



## TRY SAYING...

This color makes this point stand out/disappear.

I am not connecting these ideas yet because they are formatted inconsistently.

The size of this element tells me it is important/unimportant.
